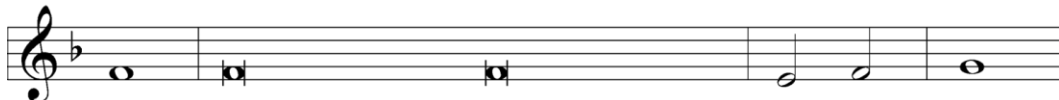

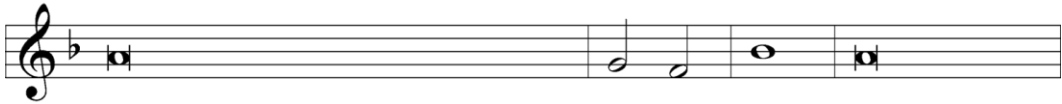

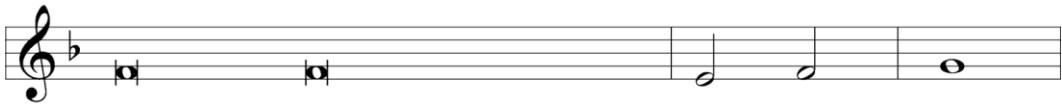

APOSTLE'S CREED – THIRD ARTICLE
