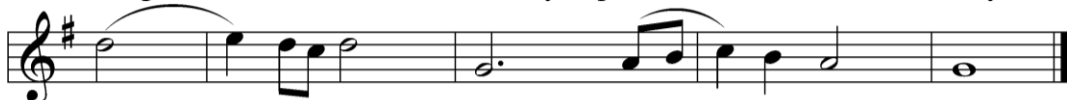

Judges 3:12-20 (CEV)

¹²Once more the Israelites started disobeying the Lord. So he let them be defeated by King Eglon of Moab,

¹³who had joined forces with the Ammonites and the Amalekites to attack Israel. Eglon and his army captured Jericho.

¹⁴Then he ruled Israel for eighteen years and forced the Israelites to pay heavy taxes.

¹⁵The Israelites begged the Lord for help, and the Lord chose Ehud from the Benjamin tribe to rescue them. They put Ehud in charge of taking the taxes to King Eglon, but before Ehud went, he made a double-edged dagger. Ehud was left-handed, so he strapped the dagger to his right thigh, where it would be hidden under his robes.

¹⁷Ehud and some other Israelites took the taxes to Eglon, who was a very fat man. As soon as they gave the taxes to Eglon, Ehud said it was time to go home.

¹⁹Ehud went with the other Israelites as far as the statues at Gilgal. Then he turned back and went upstairs to the cool room where Eglon had his throne.

NICENE CREED


