A READING FROM 1 CORINTHIANS 15:50-57 (GW)

⁵⁰ Brothers and sisters, this is what I mean: Flesh and blood cannot inherit God's kingdom. What decays cannot inherit what doesn't decay. ⁵¹ I'm telling you a mystery. Not all of us will die, but we will all be changed. ⁵² It will happen in an instant, in a split second at the sound of the last trumpet. Indeed, that trumpet will sound, and then the dead will come back to life. They will be changed so that they can live forever. ⁵³ This body that decays must be changed into a body that cannot decay. This mortal body must be changed into a body that will live forever. ⁵⁴ When this body that decays is changed into a body that cannot decay, and this mortal body is changed into a body that will live forever, then the teaching of Scripture will come true: "Death is turned into victory! ⁵⁵ Death, where is your victory?
